- 1. Revised Plan several contractors have been approached and costs are coming in slightly higher than anticipated; with this in mind a few minor changes are to be made to the MUGA to bring it into line with estimated costs; these were agreed, Martin has been asked to provide copies of details ASAP to Town Clerk to enable planning application to be submitted to East Lindsey. Kate Pinfold & Matthew Fido are keen to get working on a funding bid this is to be started ASAP.
- 2. Environmental Scheme- Planting; Groundwork have managed to secure around 400 trees these are part of an initiative scheme run by the Government and will be at no cost to Coningsby, Council have roughly 30 medium sized trees to add to this, spring bulbs will be supplied by Groundwork. Dates set for planting 24<sup>th</sup> February 2009 St Michaels School; 24<sup>th</sup> February 2009 Tattershall Primary School, with a whole community day being scheduled for Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> February; notices will be placed on Council notice boards and local groups will be invited along; refreshments are to be served in the Pavilion.
- 3. Building Regulations These are passed and awaiting the go ahead for putting out to tender, two firms tendered for the regulation application these will be contacted again plus any other that apply. Clerk to contact Mr Cartwright who has drawn up the plans for details of what to do next. Martin Ely voiced that he would be approaching the Football foundation for funding for the extensions to the building, but they would not fund Car Parking this would have to be sourced elsewhere.
- 4. Rebecca Wakefield had other commitments and was unable to attend report sent in to say a meeting with RAF Benevolent Fund to hopefully secure the suggested funding is to be held during February.
