Coningsby Town Council are looking at providing better facilities on this site; back in February 2008 Groundwork Lincolnshire carried about an extensive consultation to find out what the residents of Coningsby & the surrounding villages wanted to see on the site; this culminated in the production of a "Master Plan" lots of groups and associations gave positive feedback to a questionnaire sent out, some sent back negative; all were taken into account and we are working towards providing some if not all of the proposed facilities requested.

Summary of Consultation

- Sporting Activities Suggestions for additional sporting activities to be carried out on the site include; summer holiday clubs, reintroduction of rugby and cricket, hockey pitch, astroturf, tennis courts, equipment for children to develop sports skills, sport for the 50 plus in the villages, skate park, multi use games area, all weather facility, floodlighting.
- Other Activities- a strong conclusion from the consultation was that groups wanted other activities to be carried out on the site and not just main stream sports. Suggestions included: walking track and open space for walking, jungle walk for small children, social area for teenagers, benches, play area, nature area and trees, sheltered area, sensory garden, flowers to attract birds and wildlife.
- Pavilion It was seen that the pavilion needed to be refurbished and heated so that it could be better used for meetings with tea & coffee facilities. It was felt that toilets should be fully accessible.
