1. Notes from last meeting were confirmed as a true record, no issues.
2. Rebecca Wakefield – working with the Chief Community development officer on funding bid; details of contractors and estimated costs are needed to prove we are working towards best value not only for money but community usage etc. RAF are looking at June for a date for final decision on bid; we remain hopeful; Liz Ash to work with Rebecca on providing this information.
3. Youth Worx – Not in attendance, Youth opportunities Funding bid is being worked on Martin Ely recently visited the group to help with ideas for the bid.
4. Liz Ash – Groundwork Lincs, planning another community consultation during May these will be ongoing throughout the project to ensure we are working with the community and promote developments. Martin Ely has secured a funding bid from “WREN” for £35,000 towards the Naturalised areas, BMX track, Trim Trail and exercise equipment, with the approval of Council these works will begin late May early June. Liz will contact Lincolnshire Aggregates Levy fund regarding car park funding.
5. Town Council- Tenders have gone out to 8 contractors for the building extension and car parking areas, date for return 20th May building. Fencing to match the original Lincolnshire post & rail, surface of car park, hardcore with a topping of road planeings or similar. Thank you to all who helped with the tree planting, Mayor Cllr Paddy Donnellan and Martin Ely (Ground work) attending all sessions, schools and “Youthworx” have been awarded certificates of thanks 450 trees planted in total and around 1000 bulbs. There will be a display of photographs at the Annual Parish meeting to promote the project.
