What is Operation Nova?

A force-wide, long-term operation aimed at

1. Reducing the incidents of alcohol fuelled anti-social behaviour and violence mainly occurring in the town centres during the evenings and nights at weekends AND
2. reducing the incidents of domestic abuse.

Lincolnshire Police launch a new force wide number for contacting your police.

Again we cannot stress enough the importance of ringing through an incident the moment it is occurring. Several times over the past few months we have been made aware of incidents that have occurred days, sometimes weeks, before we are notified.

If you cannot contact your local Policing Team direct then make use of the new single non emergency number for Lincolnshire Police as displayed above.

As always in an emergency call 999

This way the details are taken at the time an incident occurs and an officer can be assigned to deal with it as it is occurring ensuring it is dealt with swiftly and efficiently.

Incidents of note/Feedback

Woodhall Spa: An Archers Survey, which measures the speed of vehicles over a certain time span, was recently carried out on Horncastle Road following on from complaints that speeding here was a serious issue. The survey covered 6 x 24 hours periods in which a total of 20,280 vehicles were checked. The average speed of all vehicles was 42 mph and of those vehicles checked just 1% were travelling at a speed at which prosecution would be an appropriate course of action. The survey shows the 50 mph speed limit is well observed and complied with.

Tattershall and Coningsby: Throughout February there were several incidents of vehicle crime within the Coningsby and Tattershall area. This included theft from and theft of motor vehicle.

Can you please ensure that:

1.) All valuables are removed from vehicles at all times, this includes satellite navigational equipment, mobile phones, stereo fronts, CD's, bag's and anything else that may be a temptation to the opportune criminal.

2.) And, that all vehicles are secured and, if fitted, alarms are set.

Thatcham Assured alarms can be purchased from most vehicle accessory outlet stores and may decrease the cost of your motor insurance.
